In the search for the 2008 Chester White Hog College Boar, the parameters used were correct feet and legs, balance, eye-appeal and predictable genetics. The road led to Williamsburg, Iowa, and when 28-3 came running out amongst his 25 contemporaries, my eyes widened. Coming from a high-health, highly productive, no-nonsense breeding program, the search was over. **"The Natural"** as I will call him, is extremely bold in his top, long, thick and expressive in his rump, naturally wide and long about his front end, extremely big bladed, loose in his rib and flank, and can walk all day long. This elite breeding boar offers all the profit traits one can demand with a beautiful profile that did his performing naturally. I truly believe he ranks among the very best among all Chester White herd sires offered for sale the past 24 months. You be the judge.

Sired by COR16 Hercules, the 2006 NBS Reserve Champion Boar that had figures at Austin of .76 BF, 9.50 LEA, 1.78 WDA. Hercules was named a NBS Super Sire in 2007, with his progeny pen ranking the 2nd best total index in the entire test, with the top soundness score of all pens tested, with pen averages of 1.88 ADG, .80 BF, 7.33 LEA. This was also the 2nd biggest loin eye average and 5th best ADG of all pens tested. 28-3 is also a littermate to the '08 Iowa State Fair Reserve Champion Gilt. The dam, Anna 32-9, is sired by the '04 NBS Champion Boar, Icecrusher, and has raised 28 pigs in 3 litters. The grandmother, Anna 28-10, is the mother of the '08 San Antonio 2nd place gilt shown by the Lackey Family (behind champion) which also was selected Champion Market and Chester Breeding Gilt at the Bexar County Texas Fair.

List also the great breeding boars in the Chester breed and names of Noble Cause, Hero, Echo Classic will surface—and all are prevalent in this guy's first five generations. Currently 60 Hercules daughters are in production at Randy and Becky Schmidt's. Very little bedding, no pay lean, commercial feed ration, competition from 15-35 other boars, does not restrict his greatness — it only endorses him. Consider "The Natural" on September 10.
