Shown by niece Leigh Honegger to a classwinner at the '08 Team Purebred National Junior Show, and 2nd at the '08 Illinois State Fair Junior Show, with a littermate boar being a classwinner at the '08 STC and yet another littermate barrow selected as Champion Spot and Reserve Overall at a major Illinois County Fair, shows strength in the litter.
