This one was a no-brainer! When the largest Chester White recorder offers an invitation to select any keeper gilt or possible show gilt from the spring pig crop as a Chester White representative for Hog College® Row, I jumped at the chance.

21-3 was an easy choice to select from a phenotypic standpoint even though the Illinois State Fair top-seller and Indiana State Fair Reserve Grand gilts were still available.

From a phenotypic standpoint, 21-3 is extremely tall fronted, attractive through her front end, heavy and flat in her bone work, long spined, lean, balanced and correct in her top line, blade and ham-loin junction, long hipped, properly muscled and as sound and sure footed as you can make one. She is just right in her width for comfort and has the look of a long lasting foundation - productive sow.

Her genetic makeup gives her even more predictability. Starting with her maternal granddam, 14-1 has weaned 78 pigs in 8 litters and has a herd SPI of 113.33. She is the mother of the 2009 San Antonio-Drymalla Champion Chester White gilt who in turn was the mother of the 2010 San Antonio Champion Chester and Supreme Champion Gilt. 14-1 is also the dam of the 2009 WPX Champion Chester White boar selected by Bradshaws at \$2,700, and also the dam of Wintex' \$10,000 private treaty purchase this spring.

The granddam (24-9) has weaned 39 pigs in 4 litters and possesses an SPI of 118.58. She is a littermate to the 2007 Indiana State Fair Champion gilt purchased by Cox & Craft. In 24-9's first litter, she produced the 2008 Indiana State Fair Jr. Champion gilt, in her 2nd litter, she produced the 2009 SWTC Champion gilt, her 3rd litter produced 4 keeper gilts for Armstrongs and in her 5th litter out of Out Cold, she produced a \$2,000 boar to Ivan McDonald. A littermate to 24-9 produced "Wicked Good."

The dam 22-2 is a littermate to the 2009 SWTC Champion gilt from her first parity with 2 littermate gilts retained in the herd. A littermate boar to the 2010 Hog College® gilt was selected as Champion boar at the 2010 Illinois State Fair.

The sire "Out Cold" was Armstrong's choice of the 2009 STC. Out Cold's dam (42-5) is a littermate to Boone at Wade Miller's and also a littermate to the dam of Bulls Eye and Ice Cube. Produced in Out Cold's first pig crop was the 2010 WPX Champion Chester gilt (Jr. Show), 2010 WPX Champion Chester barrow, STC Champion Chester and Supreme Champion barrow, Team Purebred STC Reserve Chester barrow and WPX 1st Class 1 gilt.

When selecting a Hog College animal, one should look at much more than a pretty picture. This one represents generations of power, predictability and performance with a production record that the industry and breed needs. This unique and rare opportunity is yours on Wednesday, September 15, 2010.
