This one is my kind of female — a great individual from a powerful litter of Poland hogs, bred by a family that has been very influential in breeding many outstanding hogs for lots of years. Your 2010 Poland China Hog College® gilt will excite you for her extreme flexibility of skeleton, extra length of body, great foot size and toe spread, length of rump, levelness of hip, squareness to her top and rump, true and natural width to her chest, superior underline, ease of growth and maturity to her skeleton. These are a lot of positives in a powerful female and you may look hard to find any negative features. Foundation females need to incorporate these traits to be long lasting. This exciting female will be a great asset to any successful program.

This female reads like production and her pedigree confirms it. Her maternal granddam 25-1 has had 4 parities and has raised 36 pigs. In fact, the mother of Paschen's top-selling boar at Indiana is a littermate to 5-1.

The dam 1-6 was the grand champion gilt overall breeds at Shelby County, Indiana and Reserve Poland at the 2008 Indiana State Fair Jr. Show. A half-sister was Grand overall at Shelby County and Reserve Poland at the 2009 Indiana State Fair Jr. Show, selling to Jerry Masters for \$2,900.

Wow - what a great litter 4-3 is from. Littermate barrows include Champion and Reserve at Hancock County, Champion at Huntington County, Champion at Randolph County, Reserve at Henry County and Reserve Points barrow on the Indiana Jr. Circuit.

The sire of the 2010 Hog College® gilt, "Fast Forward," was the \$9,500 top-selling boar at the 2009 STC and in his first pig crop sired the 2010 Hog College® boar on the reverse side of this page, Champion and top-selling gilt at the 2010 STC, Champion and Reserve gilt at the 2010 WPX. If one talks to Jerry Masters, he will tell you that **Masterpiece** is one of the best female sires he has ever used. You will find him on both sides of the pedigree as well as breed stalwarts Rice Rocket, No Doubt, Jaguar, Ripper, Purple Heart and "Prom Queen" included in her pedigree. Grizzly, Attitude and Vision are also prominent names that will surface several generations later.

This exciting female was not put together in a day. Years of genetic selection makes this one powerful from a genetic standpoint and her impressive phenotype will impress all. Thanks to Nolan & Ted Laird and Bill for putting this one together and for sharing her with the breed.

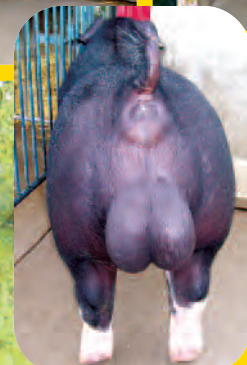
