Here she is! This elite female is impeccable in her design, balance, flexibility and stride; both front and rear. She has great length of body, excellent bone work, great length and levelness to her hip, a near perfect top line with superior breed character, underline and vulva with a show hog look and a breeding hog pedigree.

Superior production is bred deep in this gilt's pedigree as she comes from a 4th parity sow that has raised 46 pigs (11.50 ave.) Her Basil Hayden dam is the mother of Miller's \$3,500 top-selling gilt at the 2010 SWTC. From a superior litter that includes a class winning gilt at the 2010 Indiana State Fair Jr. Show, several Illinois and Indiana county fair Supreme Champion gilts and a 2nd place gilt at the 2010 WPX Jr. Show, this one heads the list.

The sire, S&L 1-1, was the Supreme Champion boar prospect at the 2009 Purple Power Sale. He has accumulated an exciting track record in his first crop of pigs including Champion and Reserve Spot barrow at the 2010 Indiana State Fair Jr. Show, 3 out of the 8 class winners at Indiana State Fair Jr. Show, Champion Spotted Barrow at 2010 Illinois State Fair open show, Reserve gilt at 2010 Indiana State Fair open show and \$4,300 top-seller and the 5th overall Spot barrow and gilt at the 2010 Team Purebred STC.

Basil Hayden was the 2006 STC Champion boar, and the sire of "Strong Arm" and also the \$6,000 2007 Spotted Hog College gilt who is the mother of "Trigger."

This one gets me excited! It won't take you long to determine this is one powerful Spotted Herd boar! As he effortlessly comes out of his pen, you will notice his herd boar skull, massive blade, big forearm, tremendous rib shape, even-big toes and true base width. When he gets to a profile view, you will appreciate his near perfect balance from shoulder to loin and loin to hip. His long, level top line is filled with a deep, thick loin, with a deep, full middle and flank. As he goes away, you will see a long, deep, level rump. The soundness in this future great is about as perfect as I have ever seen. He has great flex to his hock and ideal set to his pastern. Combine this with exceptional growth, high appetite and an awesome look, and you are seeing the future of the Spotted breed.

This boar comes from a consistent litter of hogs from a first parity female, giving one more credibility of his potential. Four littermate barrows were shown in Illinois with one being a class winner at the Illinois State Fair, another being a two time Reserve Champion at Illinois County Fair and another being a two-time 2nd place individual at competitive Illinois' County Fairs. Three littermate gilts have been retained and a littermate boar was a \$750 entry at the 2010 Indiana State Fair.

Sired by the \$16,000 Leap Frog and out of a class winning Maximus gilt at the 2009 Illinois State Fair, she raised 10 in the first litter. The grand-dam 10-6 has raised 19 pigs in two litters.

Writing a more powerful pedigree cannot be done with Leap Frog, Home Brew, One Giant Step, Mountain, Graffiti, Maximus, Movin' On, Kahlua — you have all the greats covered. This boar will fix what fails so many Spotted hogs. We need to make no more excuses about flexibility, growth, bone, width, balance, muscle or the stress gene.
