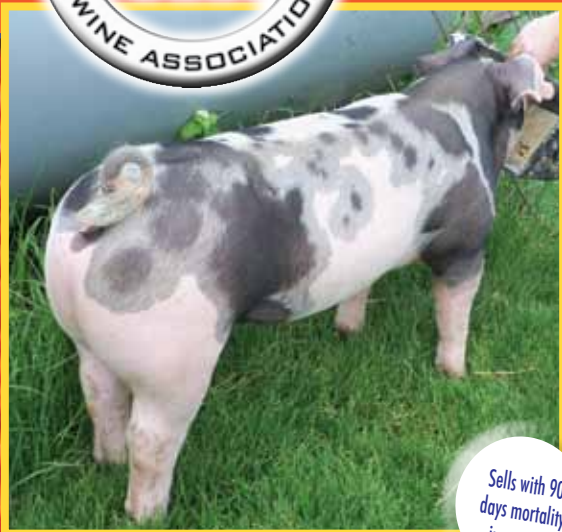

Fact be known, Chris Brazel did not know this letter was ever written or sent until months later. After sharing the news and discussing the topic with Chris in December, he said he would be committed to his family's wishes and would be honored to share with Team Purebred his absolute best female born this spring.

Your 2010 Team Purebred Foundation Female comes not only from a generating family of elite hogs but just as importantly from a family of love, compassion and dedication. Sons Zachery (9) and Zander (4), although young in years, understand that hard work and dedication are the keys to success. They know that Team Purebred is an avenue for future generations of Spotted breeders to advance their educational and life skills. Chris and Deb have raised them right and this is your opportunity to be part of the Team Purebred and Spotted breed families.

The genetic composition of this exciting Spotted female is truly amazing. Sired by CH19 S&L 1-1, the 2009 Purple Power Sift Supreme Champion Boar and now housed at Purple Power and whose dam is the cornerstone of the Brazel program is by LP1 Pol-Ka-Dot 3-3. S&L had two powerful littermates, one being a gilt that was 4th overall at the 2009 Team Purebred National Junior Show and the other littermate barrow that was 3rd overall at the same event. S&L's mother was sired by B&B on B&B's littermate sister.

The dam of this great Foundation Female is a 5th parity sow that has farrowed 53 pigs and weaned 52. In her first litter she was bred to Damage Control and produced a gilt selling to Down & Vogel that in turn was the mother of the 2009 Tulsa Champion Spotted Gilt for the Goss family and also produced the 2009 Team Purebred National Junior Show Reserve Champion Barrow for the Wechter family. This barrow was also second in points on the Indiana Show Circuit.

An extended pedigree of this female is represented by many of the most popular Spotted boars in the breed. The paternal grand sire, SOS, has had 93 litters registered; his sire, High Hope, 129 litters; and his grand sire, One Giant Step, 268 litters. B&B has had 291 litters recorded and with World Wide, Sudden Impact and B53 included, why would you not get excited.

The Pol-Ka-Dot, Deciple and Maui genetics on the bottom side insures productivity, longevity and eye appeal.

Now as we study this female that is the best one ever let go from Brazels, you will see an incredibly sound structured, perfectly marked female with true and natural width of chest, proper frame size, excellent bone, level and square and thick in her hip with a show ring look that won't quit. You will find a great underline and excellent vulva to match.

Only because of the Brazel commitment to Team Purebred and their belief that families need to work together and share their love for the industry that they offer this female.
